





# Technical Bulletin for: Chinese White Pine Beetle

*Dendroctonus armandi* (Tsai & Li) • Coleoptera, Curculionidae • DENARM



<b>DISTRIBUTION</b>	Asia, particularly China.
<b>HOSTS</b>	Chinese White Pine
<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	
<b>Adult Moth</b>	Light brownish in color with a dark head. Averages roughly 5 mm in length, similar to other <i>Dendroctonus</i> species
<b>Larvae</b>	
<b>Eggs</b>	
<b>LIFE HISTORY</b>	Life cycle is completed entirely under the bark of the host tree. Adults take wing to search for new host trees. About 2-3 generations can be completed per year, depending on elevation.

<b>LURE ACTIVE INGREDIENTS, SUBSTRATE &amp; FIELD LIFE</b>	(+)alpha-pinene, alpha-phellandrene and camphene in an 8 mil pouch with foam sponge. Lure Longevity: 45 days.	
<b>TRAP TO USE</b>	Panel Trap	
<b>MONITORING STRATEGY</b>	Contact your local forester for more information on forest management practices.	
<b>CULTURAL &amp; PHYSICAL CONTROL</b>	Remove infested/dead trees, including those blown over by the wind.
