





Technical Bulletin for: Chinese White Pine Beetle

Dendroctonus armandi (Tsai & Li) • Coleoptera, Curculionidae • DENARM



DISTRIBUTION	Asia, particularly China.
HOSTS	Chinese White Pine
DESCRIPTION	
Adult Moth	Light brownish in color with a dark head. Averages roughly 5 mm in length, similar to other <i>Dendroctonus</i> species
Larvae	No information available.
Eggs	No information available.
LIFE HISTORY	Life cycle is completed entirely under the bark of the host tree. Adults take wing to search for new host trees. About 2-3 generations can be completed per year, depending on elevation.

MONITORING INFORMATION

LURE ACTIVE INGREDIENTS, SUBSTRATE & FIELD LIFE	(+)alpha-pinene, alpha-phellandrene and camphene in an 8 mil pouch with foam sponge. Lure Longevity: 45 days.	
TRAP TO USE	Panel Trap	
MONITORING STRATEGY	Place traps near at least 1m away from host trees, at least 1.5m off the ground. When using multiple traps, space by at least 20-30m. Contact your local forester for more information on forest management practices.	
CULTURAL & PHYSICAL CONTROL	Remove infested/dead trees, including those blown over by the wind.
