

## Technical Bulletin for: Brown-winged Green Bug

Plautia stali (Scott) • Hemiptera, Pentatomidae • PLASTA

DISTRIBUTION	Japan, China, Korea, Russian Far East, Hawa'ii.
Ноѕтѕ	Various Fruit Trees, notably persimmon, citrus, stone fruits and Japanese pear
DESCRIPTION	
Adult	9.0-12.7 mm in length, convex body shape, generally green- occasionally brownish-yellow or blue.
Larvae	There can be up to 5 instars.
Eggs	
LIFE HISTORY	The developmental period averages roughly 40 days. Development of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th instars averages 5, 7, 5, 6, and 10 days, respectively. Adults reproduce in summer on planted Japanese cypress and cedar trees, using cones as food sources
MONITORING INFORMATION	
LURE ACTIVE INGREDIENTS, SUBSTRATE & FIELD LIFE	Murgantiol in a coaster lure packet. Lure longevity: 30 days.
TRAP TO USE	Brown Marmorated Stink Bug Trap or clear 12x12" sticky trap
MONITORING STRATEGY	Check with cooperative extension or Master Gardener for local information and recommendations.
CULTURAL & PHYSICAL CONTROL	Check cones of plantation cypress and/or cedar for adults and/or larvae, removing them as necessary.
